There will be face coverings required, temp checks, sanitation and distancing (same as we've been doing since March).** We have two gym areas and a separate awards area. I'll have a plan to send out next week to the clubs after the conference center approves the floor plan, spectators and awards area specs. Flexibility and patience is key this season!
